## **A LETTER FROM THE REVD CANON PETER LEE**

Dear Parishioners,

### **RENEWAL**

September sees the start of a new season. Its 'back to school' for the younger generation and many activities start up again after the summer break. Hopefully it will see the start of a renewal in the life of our Parish with the return of our Rector. Although it has been a difficult time it has been good to see how so many have 'stepped up' to take on tasks and ensure the life and witness of the Parish have continued. When I was a Rector we had a special service each September to renew the vows we had made at the Induction Service for a new Rector. As the years go by its difficult to remember the promises Rector and Parishioners made at that service.

Those promises centred first at the Font for new life in God's family. The Bishop said: "The Church is called in the power of the Holy Spirit to proclaim to all people eternal life in Christ Jesus and fellowship in his Church. People of this Parish it is your duty to share with your Parish Priest in spreading the Good News of Christ, to help those received by Baptism to continue in the life of the Church, and to know what a Christian ought to believe and practice. Will you do all in your power to build up the life and fellowship of the Church?"

Then at the Pulpit for growth in God's family the Bishop said: "Members of Christ's Church in this Parish should seek to grow in faith and knowledge of God by Bible reading and private prayer. They should pray continually for the work of the Church, for its Ministers and for each other. It is their responsibility in company with other Christians where they live, to show themselves to be the Body of Christ, giving service to the community through the grace of him who died and rose again for us all. Will you seek by prayer, word and action to do these things?"

Finally at the Altar for worship in God's family the Bishop said: "The Church is called to share the life of Christ by receiving his word and sacraments, and to grow in fellowship with him and with each other. It is every member's duty to share in worship with others each Sunday, to receive Holy Communion faithfully and regularly, and to bear witness to Christ in daily life and work, seeking his will and living to his glory."

After each of these questions put by the Bishop everyone responded "We will, with the help of God." As we pray for renewal in our own life and the life of this Parish perhaps it is an opportunity to refresh our memory of those questions and to respond "we will, with the help of God."

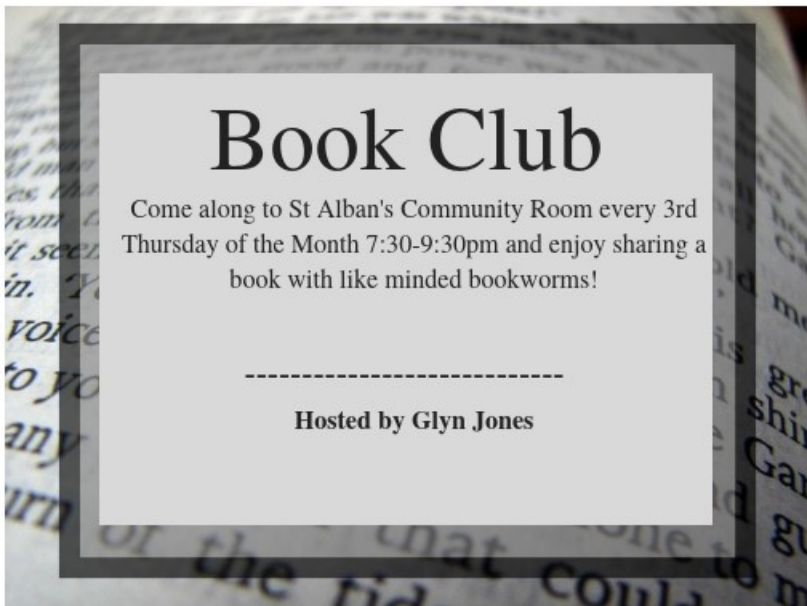

## 20 mph Speed Limits in the Village

We have received confirmation from CW&C that the 20 mph speed limits on certain roads in and around Tattenhall came into effect, as of 14<sup>th</sup> June 2019. All signs should now be uncovered.

## Housing in Tattenhall

CW&C has now adopted its Local Plan, Parts one and two, which outlines housing objectives for the next 5 years. Within the plan, the policy states that Tattenhall's housing requirements are for 250 homes to be built between 2010 and 2030.

## Squirrel Trail

We have been thrilled with the response to the Squirrel Trail and it is great to see local residents and visitors still talking about them and getting enjoyment from seeing them about. The squirrels will be waving their tails goodbye around Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September. We thank all of the businesses, community groups and families who took part in this, the first year of the trail. The Parish Council would like to do it all again next year where we hope to have even more squirrels making Tattenhall their home over the summer. So that this year's models can be re-used, please store yours for the winter, or contact the Clerk if you don't have anywhere to keep it. Watch this space!

## Best Kept Village

The Parish Council wishes to thank everyone who took part in the litter-picks, pulling weeds or 'adding colour' through planting beautiful flowers and shrubbery during Tattenhall's 'Best Kept Village' campaign this year. The judges came and met with some Parish Councillors when they gave some great positive feedback, which was lovely to hear. The 'official result' will be out later this year.

In the meantime, we hope to keep Tattenhall still sparkling with everyone's help and little contributions. Although afraid of sounding like a well-known supermarket, 'every little

helps' so "doing a good deed by pulling a weed" would be very much appreciated. .

## Hedge-Cutting around the Village

The Parish Council has received comments regarding hedges which have encroached onto public pavements and pathways, making it difficult for pedestrians to pass.

The Local Authority states that '*all hedges in private ownership should be cut back to your boundary edge and not overhang any other land or public areas*'. Even if you have an immaculately cut hedge (of which there are many in Tattenhall), it must still adhere to the boundary edge.

Please check your hedges and ensure that they do not encroach onto pavements, roads and/or public areas.

## Flooding on Paths around School

The Parish Council has received several complaints regarding the flooding of the footpath by school. This path is NOT owned by the Parish Council and is actually the responsibility of the CW&C Education Property Department. Residents' concerns have been reported to CW&C and Councillors also encouraged parents/community users to report the flooding using the online reporting tools found on the CW&C website.

The Council has now agreed to undertake works to clear the drains and it is hoped that this will result in no future flooding. The Parish Council will continue to monitor this and report it where needed.

By the time of reading this, many of you will be preparing to go back to school/work or may even be back already. We hope you had a wonderful summer (even if the weather was unpredictable!) and are looking forward to the autumn months ahead. Dare I say that some of you may have even started the countdown to Christmas (No...? Not yet!)

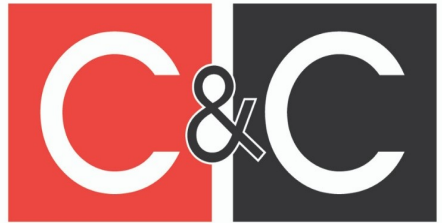
